## State of the Kent Special Riding Program

### **Our Mission**

**Kent Special Riding Program** is a nonprofit organization dedicated to providing high quality therapeutic and recreational horseback riding instruction to physically, mentally, and emotionally challenged individuals in Kent and surrounding counties. KSRP strives to maximize the potential of all individuals involved in the program in a safe and stimulating environment.

### Some facts about KSRP:

- In 2007, the Kent Special Riding Program served 276 students.
- Our actual expenses to provide this experience came to \$47,858.
- KSRP charges each student \$10.00 for a 6-week riding session. Not everyone can afford this fee, so for some, this fee is waived.
- The actual cost per rider to take part in a 6-week session is \$173.40.
- Income from student fees came to \$2,140. Only 4.5% of our expenses were covered by student fees.
- KSRP supports 13-15 horses per year, at a cost of about \$750 per horse.
- Other expenses include: Salaries for Instructors, Aides and Horse Feeders; insurance, taxes, equipment, continuing education, grounds and maintenance.
- The annual Ride-a-Thon is our major fundraiser, bringing in \$18,653 in 2007. Other income comes from grants and donations.

We have a small but very dedicated group of volunteers that work to run the Kent Special Riding Program. But we can't do it alone.

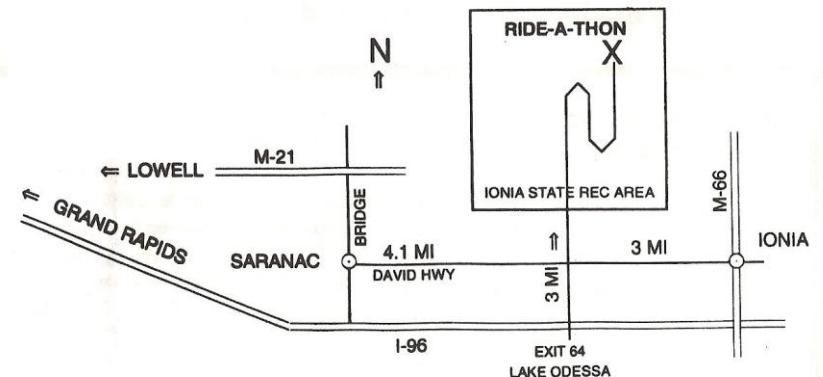
