

KSRP Barn Rules

These Rules are set for any person that enters the premises of Kent Special Riding Program. The Rules are for everyone's safety so please follow them to stay safe, as horses are easily spooked.

1. The parent/guardian/caregiver who brings each rider to KSRP must remain on site at all times the rider is at KSRP.
2. No running in the indoor or outdoor arena.
3. For safety reasons, only students, instructors, or volunteers are to be in the indoor or outdoor arena (without permission from the instructor).
4. All visitors and families should observe the riding class from a safe distance.
5. Parents, please supervise your children who are not riding.
6. Dogs must be kept on a leash and under control at all times. Dogs are only allowed in the parking area and the grassy area near the picnic table. Dogs are not allowed in the indoor or outdoor arena, tack room, classroom, mounting area or on the trails.
7. Parents and visitors should refrain from conversing with the riders during class time. The instructor needs the rider's full attention.
8. No playing on the Ramps, Bridge, or Mounting Blocks.
9. Do not walk on the trails during class unless permitted by the instructor; it spooks the horses.
10. Do not go in white barns, horse pastures or paddocks, or pet the horses in those areas without permission from the instructor.
11. For safety reasons, only instructor or aide should be in paddock or pasture areas to catch horses (unless otherwise directed by instructor).
12. Do not walk up to the house on the hill; that is private property.
13. Do not feed horses. They will always be looking for food and could bite.
14. No Smoking on the premises of KSRP; this is a smoke free area.
15. Watch very carefully when arriving and leaving, since there are many young children each day.
16. Do not visit KSRP on your own when no one is here.
17. Riders should report to instructor and remain with the class.
15. Riders are asked to leave a message at the barn (891-0057) if they are not coming to class.
16. Riders must wear a helmet in the indoor and outdoor arenas. It is the Instructor's discretion to require a helmet for anyone else (ie, siblings, etc).
17. Anyone near a horse must wear closed-toe shoes to protect their feet.
18. All students and volunteers working with the same horse, should remain on the same side of the horse while it's tied for grooming and tacking.
19. Do not crawl underneath the belly of a horse, and do not go under the neck of a horse when it is tied.
20. Always keep out of kicking range when walking behind a horse.
21. Do not wrap the lead rope around any body part.
22. Never tie a horse when a rider is on it.
23. The instructor or aide will bridle the horses, unless otherwise directed.

Remember that the riding program and all participants are guests of the Schumacher family. Your cooperation with these rules and general courtesy will insure a safe and enjoyable atmosphere for all of us.
